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

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY:

The PSEi closed March at 6,443.09, down 5.2% from the previous month, primarily due to the number of COVID19 cases. With this surge the government reimposed the ECQ in NCR and surrounding areas. Experts believe the surge was caused by looser quarantine measures as well as the entry of new virus variants. On a positive note, President Duterte signs the CREATE Act into law, which effectively lowers corporate income tax from 30% to 25% or 20% for MSMEs. Also, the country finally received COVID19 vaccines from the COVAX facility and many of our frontliners have received their first jab.

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

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

August inflation print of 4.9%, which is higher than market expectations, may cause volatility to the local bourse.

The PSEi closed the year at 7,122.63, down 1.09% from the previous month. Primarily due to the hawkish comments from Fed Chair and the local inflation number that BSP expects to breach their 2021 target. Moving forward the local bourse may react to the COVID numbers as rise due to Omicron.
